20. Students of the Department qualified UGC Net in this academic Year – the students are Lakshmi, Sneha M M of I MA Malayalam

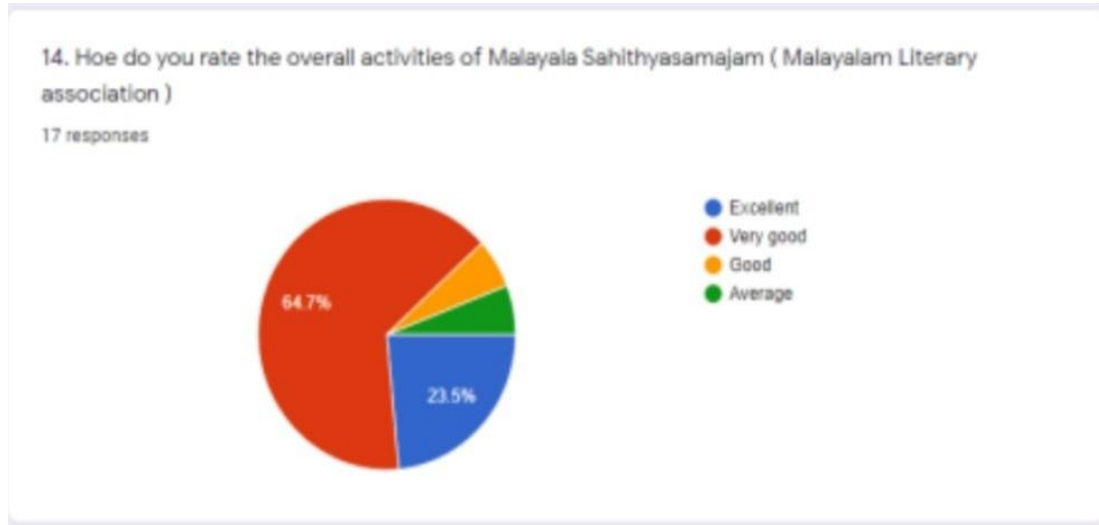
