The activities of the Department of Mathematics for the academic year 2020-21 started in the month of April 2020 in online mode. The Department organised an international webinar on "The Man who knew Infinity" commemorating Srinivasa Ramanujan, on 26.4.2020 in connection with 100th Death Anniversary of Srinivasa Ramanujan. Professor Emeritus Dr. A Vijayakumar, CUSAT who is the Vice President of Ramanujan Mathematical Society, was the resource person.

The Department organised an International Webinar on Life and Contributions of Maryam Mirzakhani on 12.5.2020 in connection with Women in Mathematics Day, 2020. Dr. Nikita Agarwal, Associate Professor in Mathematics, Indian Institute of Science, Education & Research (IISER), Bhopal was the resource person.

The Department organised Expert Talk Series for Undergraduate Students under which two National Level webinar sessions were conducted on the topic "Laplace Transforms", on 15.5.2020 and 20.5.2020. Mr. Sumesh G., Assistant Professor, Department of Science & Humanities was the resource person.

The Department organised a webinar series for 6th Semester B. Sc Mathematics students of M. G University. The sessions of the series were conducted on 24.5.2020, 25.5.2020, 29.5.2020, 30.5.2020 and 13.6.2020. The topics covered include Complex Analysis, Linear Algebra and Latex Typesetting.

Sr. Bencita Endowment Lecture as a National Webinar on the topic "SIR and its Extension for Modelling Epidemic Diseases", on 10th July, 2020 in memory of Rev. Sr. Bencita CTC, Former Principal & Head of the Department of Mathematics. Dr. Sudheesh K Kattumannil, Associate Professor, Indian Statistical Institute, Chennai was the resource person. The webinar was presided by Rev. Sr. Sharin, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics.

Conducted Webinar on Online Tutoring in Mathematics on 16.9.2020 during 3-4 pm, in association with OSAX. All second year and third year students of the department attended. Ms Twinkle Paul Mampilly, Managing Director, Twiline Solutions Pvt. Ltd who is an alumna of the department was the resource person.

Conducted Webinar on "Stress Management during Pandemic", in association with Counselling Cell, on 7.9.2020, during 11-12 pm. All second year and third year students of the department attended. Sr. Ruby, Counsellor, Prashanthi Counselling Centre was the resource person.

In connection with World Statistics Day and Prof C. R. Rao Birth Centenary year observance, the department conducted intercollegiate online PPT competition, Portrait Drawing Competition and intercollegiate online quiz in Statistics on 21.9.2020, to honour Prof C R Rao, a living legend in Statistics.

The Department conducted Webinar on Environmental Mathematics for V Sem B. Sc Mathematics students of various colleges under M G University, on 18.11.2020. Dr Savitha K. S, Assistant Professor & HOD, St Paul's College, Kalamassery was the resource person.

An online competition on Creative Problem Solving was conducted through Google Form on 21.11.2020 and best solutions were identified. 24 students took part in the competition, out of which 6 were selected.

Department organised Online quiz competition on the topic "Life and contributions of Srinivasa Ramanujan", in connection with National Mathematics Day, on 22/12/2020.

Mathematics Association activities was inaugurated by Dr Sunny Kuriakose, Academic Secretary-Kerala Mathematical Association & Dean (Academic & Administration), FISAT, Mookkanoor on 22/12/2020. A talk on Importance of National Mathematics Day was delivered by the Chief Guest.

The Department conducted remedial and revision classes for all batches in online mode. Under the Additional Support Programme for SC students, online remedial classes for Mathematics and Statistics were arranged exclusively for SC students.

The students and teachers of the department created lock down redesigns which included crafts, paintings, cuisines etc.

Students of the department prepared teaching videos for school children of classes 9 to 12, and uploaded the same in You Tube.

Department together with Staff Association organised an online condolence meeting in memory of Prof Rita Mary Thomas, Former Faculty of the Department who passed away on 26th December 2020.

Department organised an online Alumni Meet on 9th January 2021 at 3 pm.

Mary Anju P. J of second year B. Sc Mathematics was the winner of All Kerala Elocution Contest , conducted by ASAP Ernakulam.

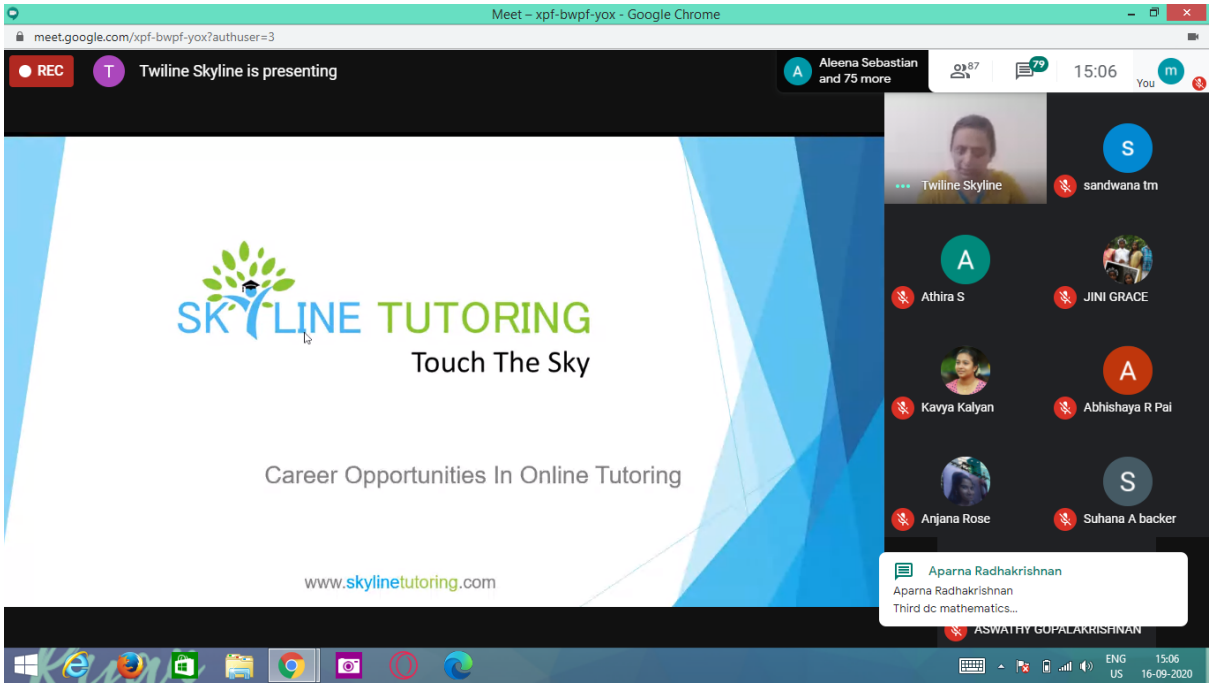

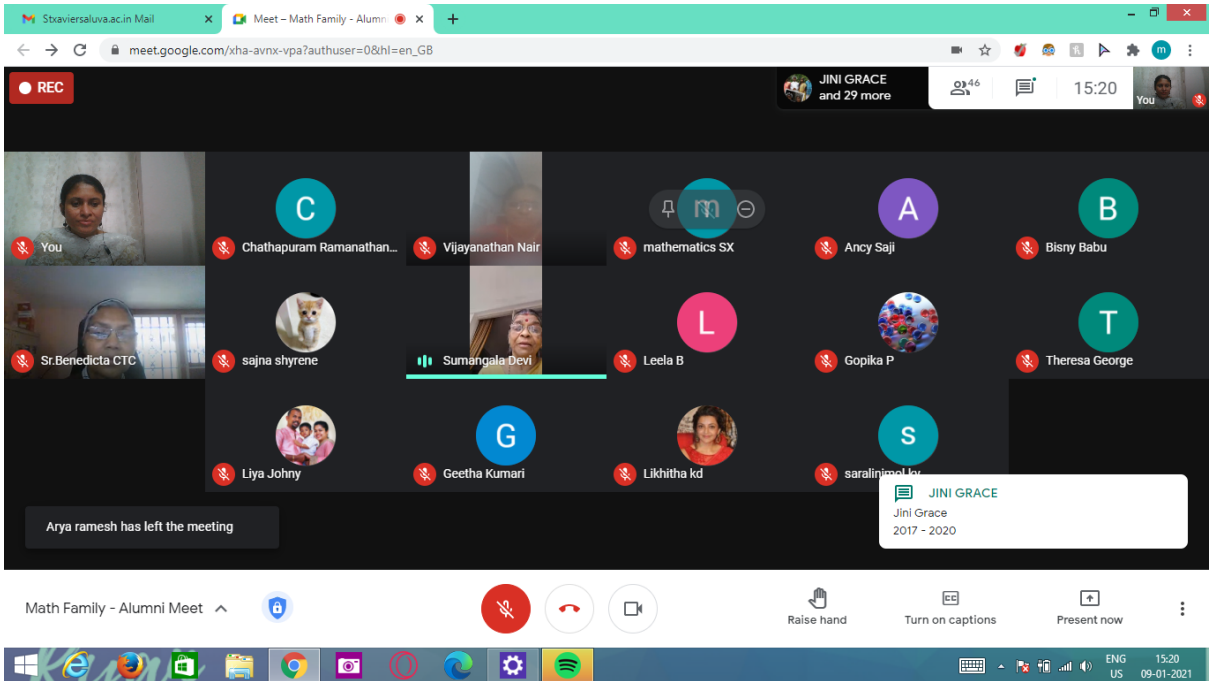
