



1. POUR LA NATURE – WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2021






2. Introductory Workshop series on Virtual Labs


It was an enlightening session for the students about different job and higher studies opportunities in the field of Physics.






4. Energy Conservation and Management awareness program



5. Inauguration of Physics Association & Webinar on Laser and its Medical Applications



6. International Webinar on "STEMming the tide: Fostering girls to STEM in particular Physics"



7. Motivational talk on NET, JRF, SET preparation








8. Webinar on Problem-solving to Mechanics

















10. Induction programme for First Year Degree students
