## Report of PTA (2017-2018)

PTA has been strongly supporting all the academic and non-academic activities of the college. The annual general body meeting was conducted on 3/11/17, in which about 700 parents participated. A PTA executive committee was formed from the gathering, which consisted of the principal, 8 parents and 8 teachers. Further, 4 committee meetings were held during the course of this academic year, in which many important issues were addressed.

Following are the main activities done by the PTA during this year. A sum of Rs.7 lakh was given for the construction of college foyer. Gold medals were awarded to the rank holders of M.Sc. and B.Sc. University Degree examinations. Cash prizes and certificates were distributed to the students who secured highest marks in the internal, Moral and Catechism examinations. Outstanding students of NSS, NCC, tourism club, Sports, and Award winners from the NSS unit and College Youth Festival were presented with awards. The coaches of volleyball and basketball were honored by awarding cash prizes. Gifts were presented to the retired teaching and non-teaching staffs. Financial support was extended for the set up of the digital section of the college main library. Rs.50000 was given to the NSS Unit for house construction of a poor family and 20000 for the medical needs of two students of the college. A sum of 3 lakh rupees was allotted to all PG and UG departments for purchasing library books. As part of upgrading all the classrooms into smart classes, projectors were installed in 4 departments.

An orientation class by Fr. Tom Pannalakunnil MSFS, EdD was held for the parents of 1<sup>st</sup> year degree students on 29/06/17 while a moral class by Dr. N Jayashankar IRS, Income Tax Commissioner was held for the students on 4/01/17. PTA also conducted a Seminar for students and teachers on "Heartfullness"-A way of meditation by famous writer and trainer Mr. Joshua Pollock U.S.A.



The PTA took care of all the financial expenses of the NSS van that is being used for their Pain and Palliative Care activities. A sum of Rs 10,000 was given for the conduction of NSS camp. Rupees 1 lakh was given to meet the expenses of Youth Festival and Rs 25000 for the All Kerala Inter collegiate Basket Ball and Volley Ball Tournament conducted by the college. PTA had also given financial support for the International Seminar conducted by the Department of commerce, Economics, Microbiology, mathematics and commerce (SF). Rs 25000 was given for the activities of the research promotion council and placement cell each. Rs 1 lakh each was given to the Department of Physics for purchasing chairs for their seminar hall and purchasing books for the setup of their research library. For the publication of the college magazine, rupees 55000 were given.
