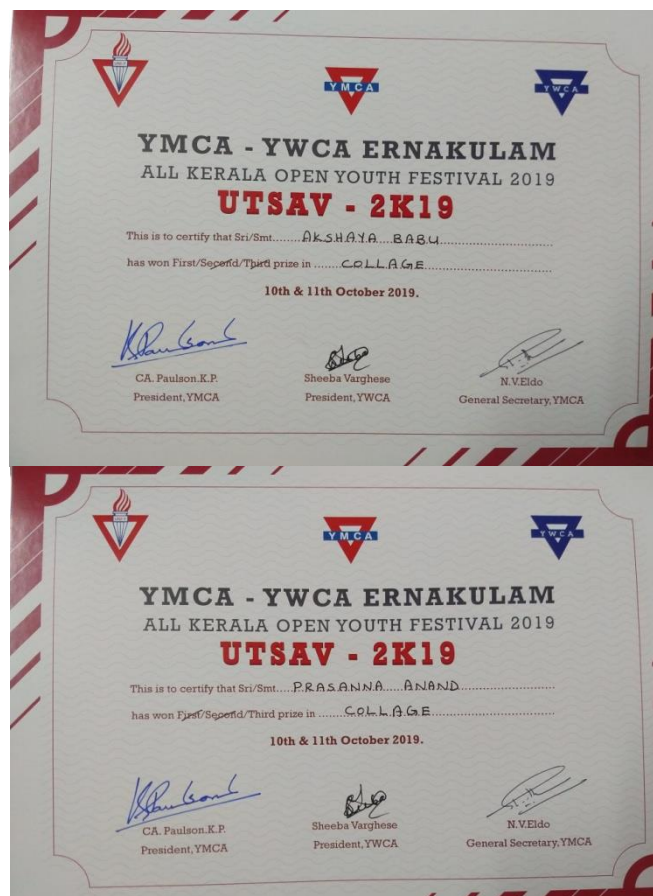
6.Participated in All Kerala Open youth festival 2019 organised by YMCA(certificates attached)
