Sexual Harrassment Prevention Cell

The University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2015 was issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (University Grant Commission) on May 2, 2016. The Regulation outlines higher educational institutions' duties in terms of preventing sexual harassment in the campus. As per the regulation sexual harassment prevention cell is established in the college to sensitize students and all other stakeholders about issues relating to any act of sexual harassment and also to take appropriate action against such acts in the campus.

Methods of Registering Complaints

Any complaints on matters of sexual harassment can be submitted directly to the principal or to the convenors of the cell. The complaints can be submitted in written format or via email.

Objective

To prevent, prohibit and redress any kind of sexual harassment that takes place in the campus on women employees or students.

Relevance

The UGC Regulation and constitution of Sexual harassment Prevention Cell is a significant step forward in making higher education more accessible to women in the country. It places a legal obligation on all higher educational institutions to create a campus free of discrimination. The safety of women therefore becomes a primary concern through the strict vigilance against sexual harassment.
