B) Student Feedback on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-22



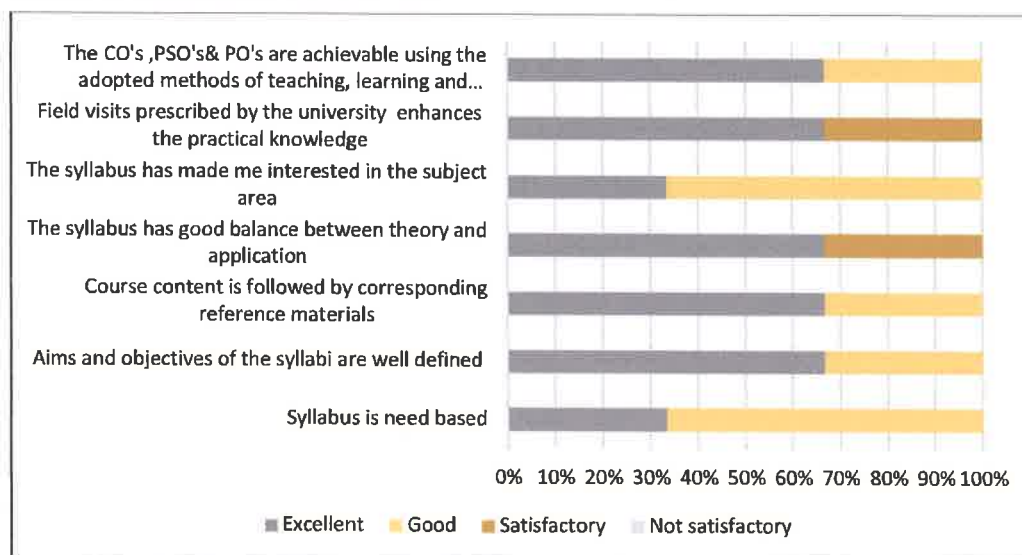

Suggestions if any:

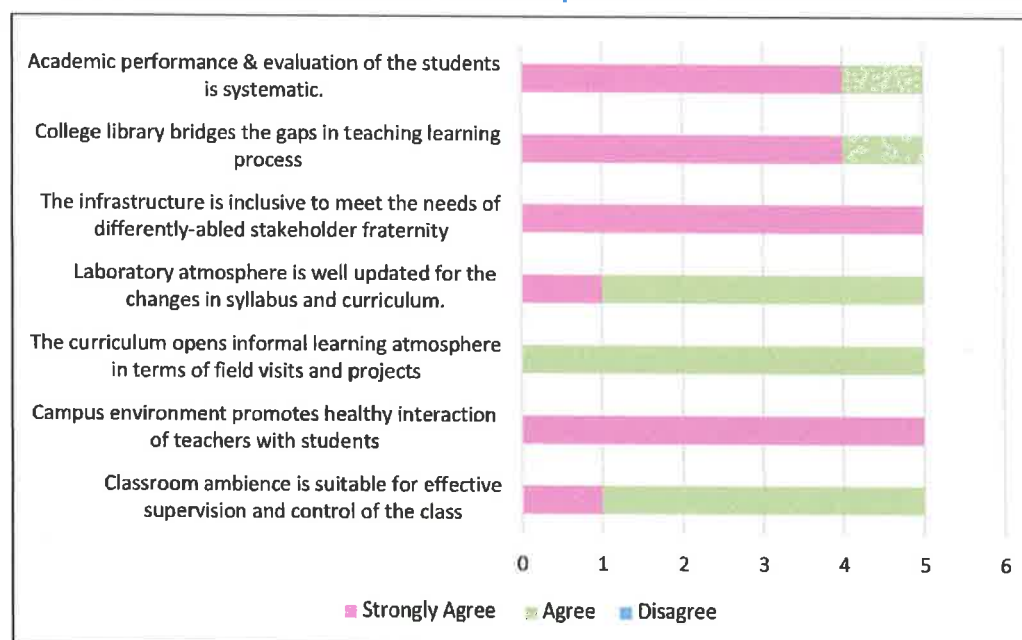
- Course provides vivid topics which expands the student's level of knowledge.

B) Teacher's Feedback on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022



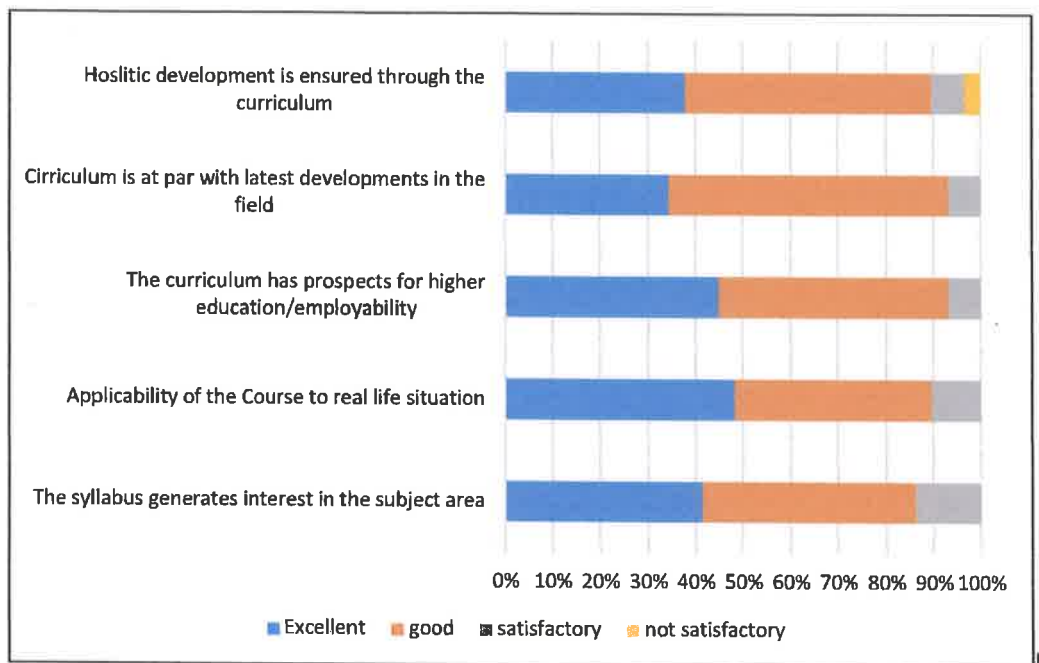

Graphical representation of feedback



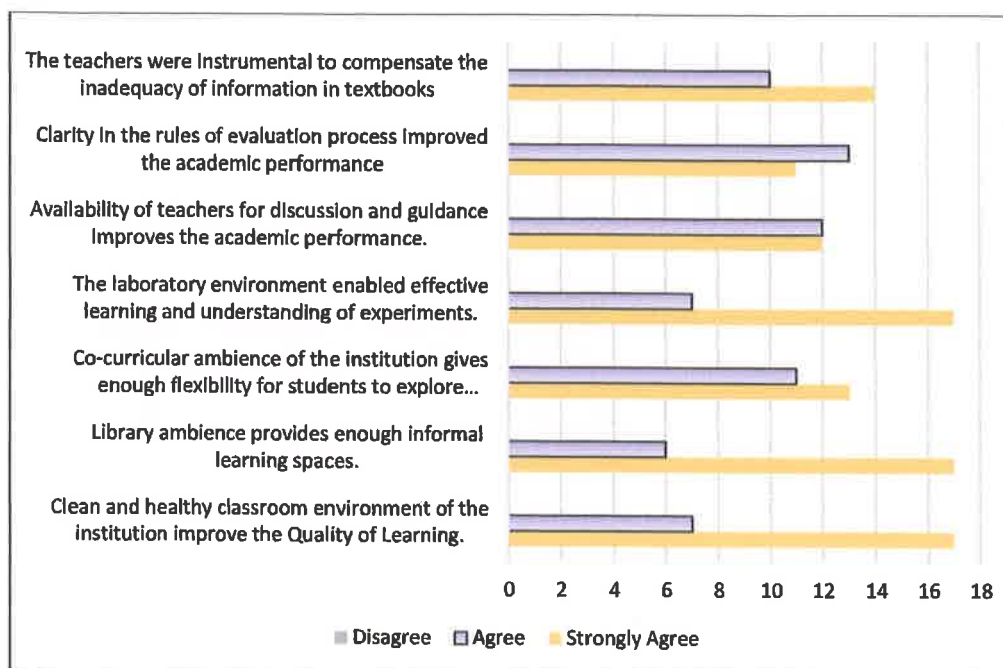

Suggestions if any:

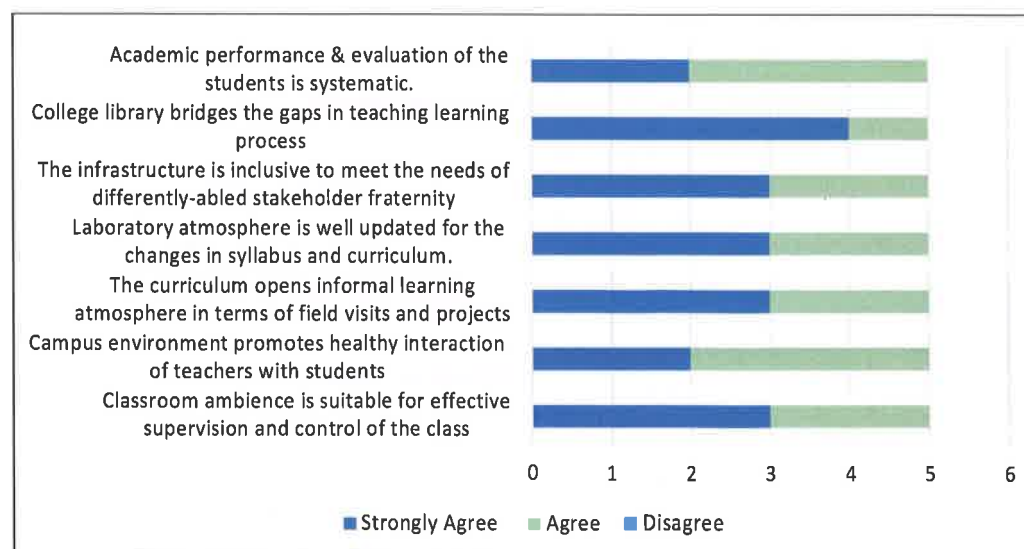
- Computational add on is very helpful

B) Student Feedback Analysis on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022



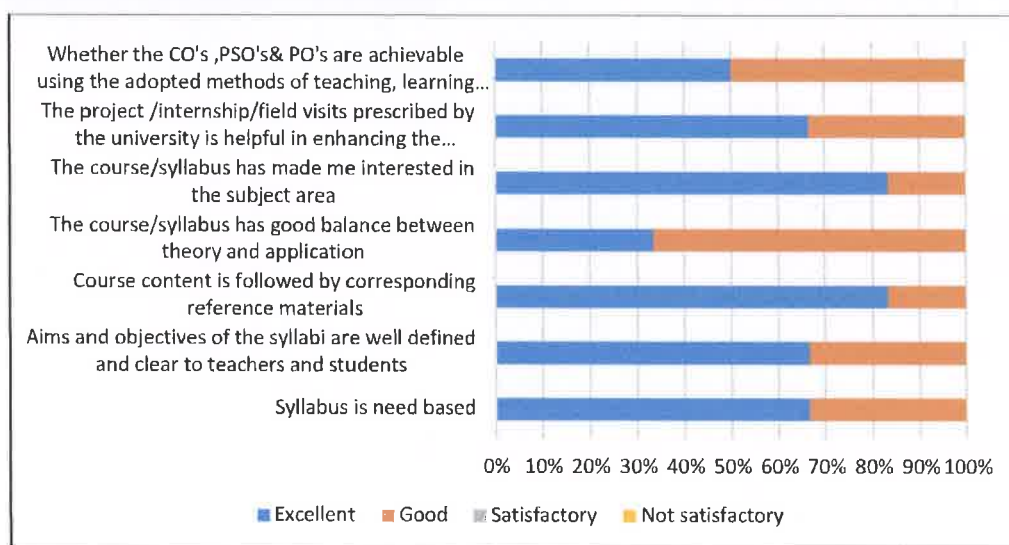

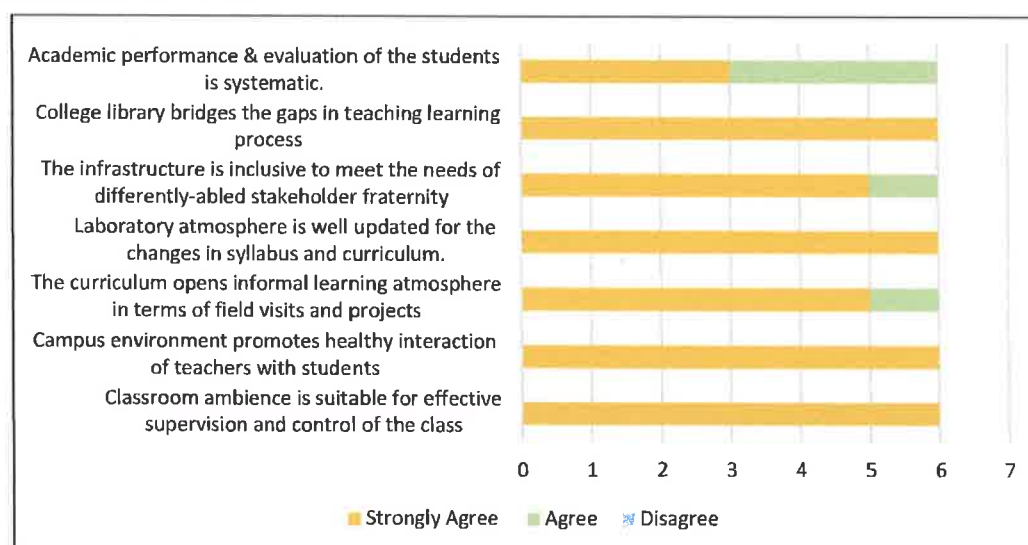

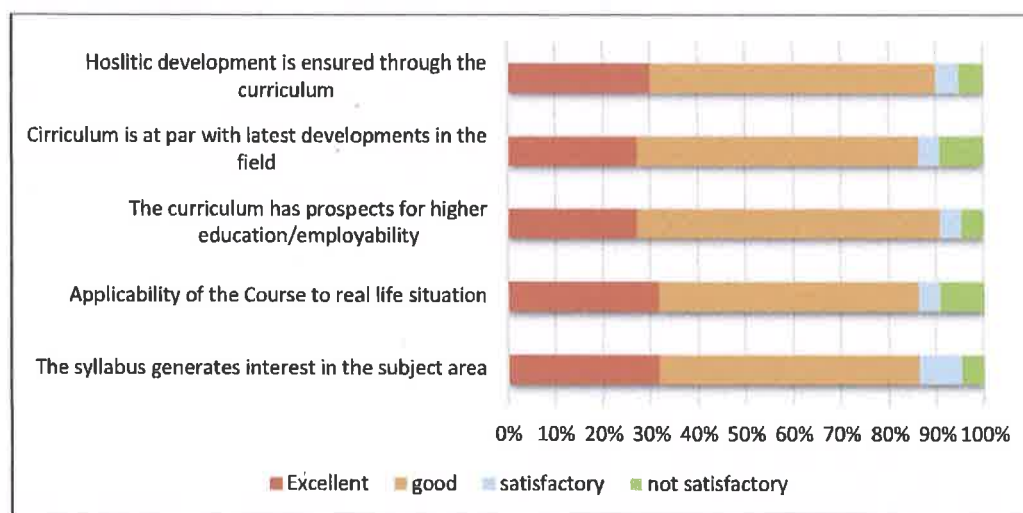

Graphical representation of feedback



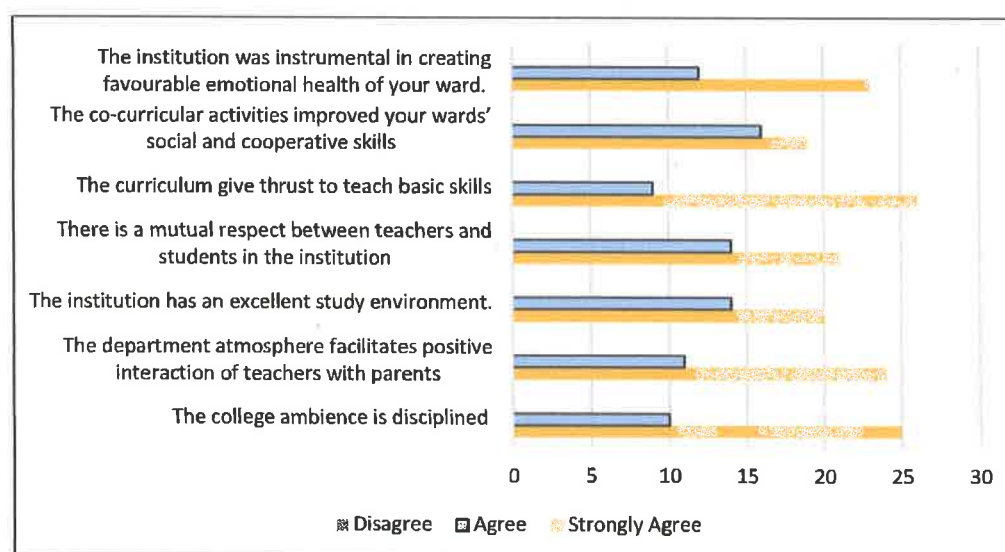

B) Student Feedback Analysis on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022



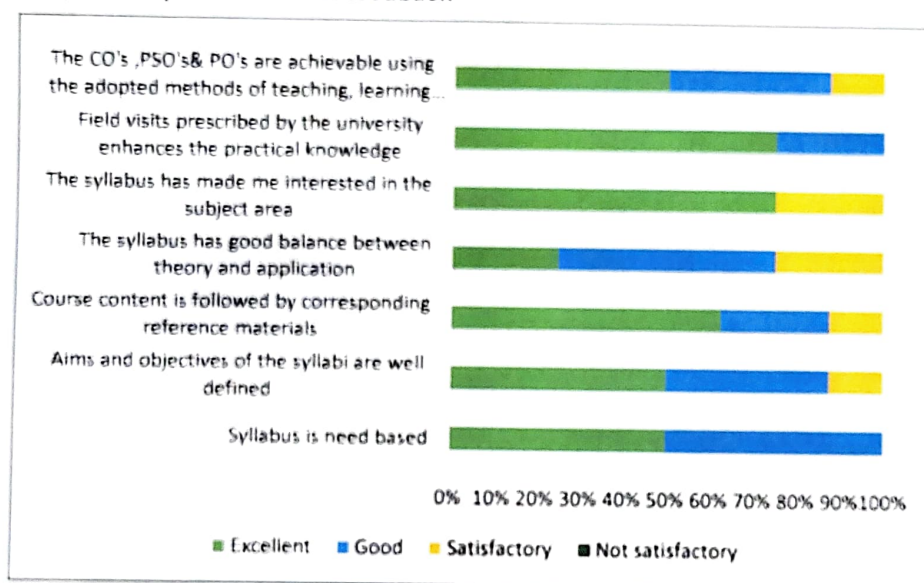

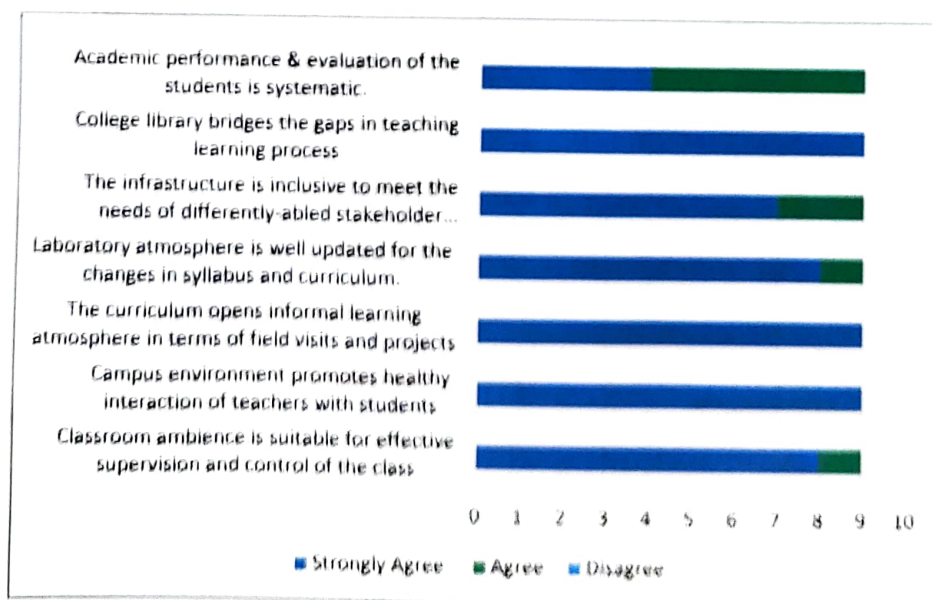

Graphical representation of feedback

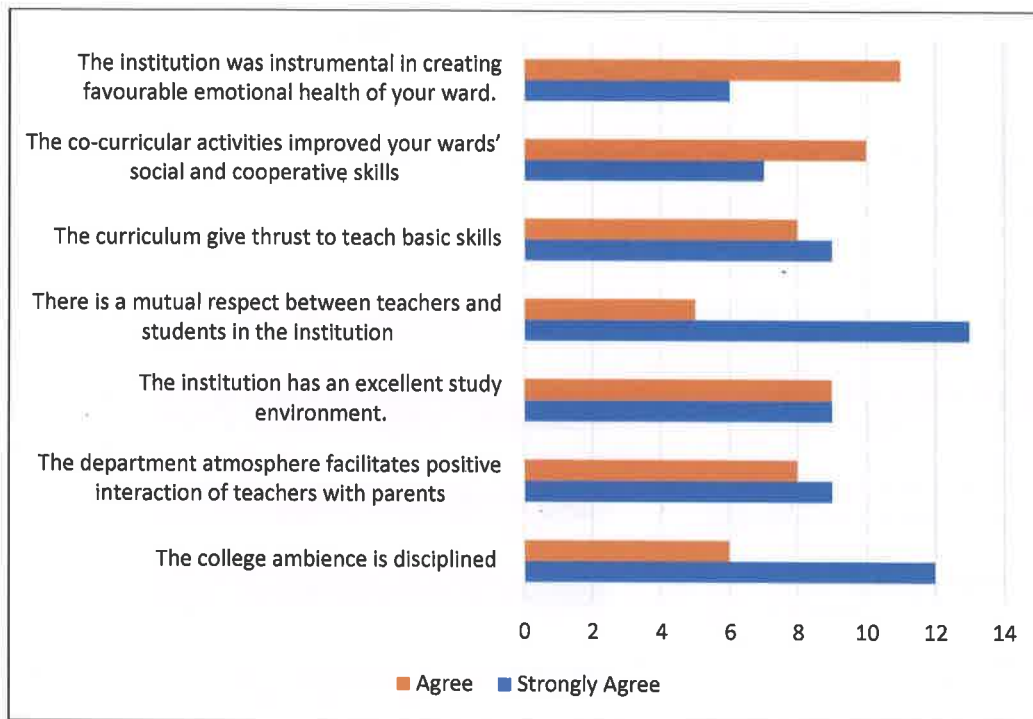


B) Teacher's Feedback Analysis on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022

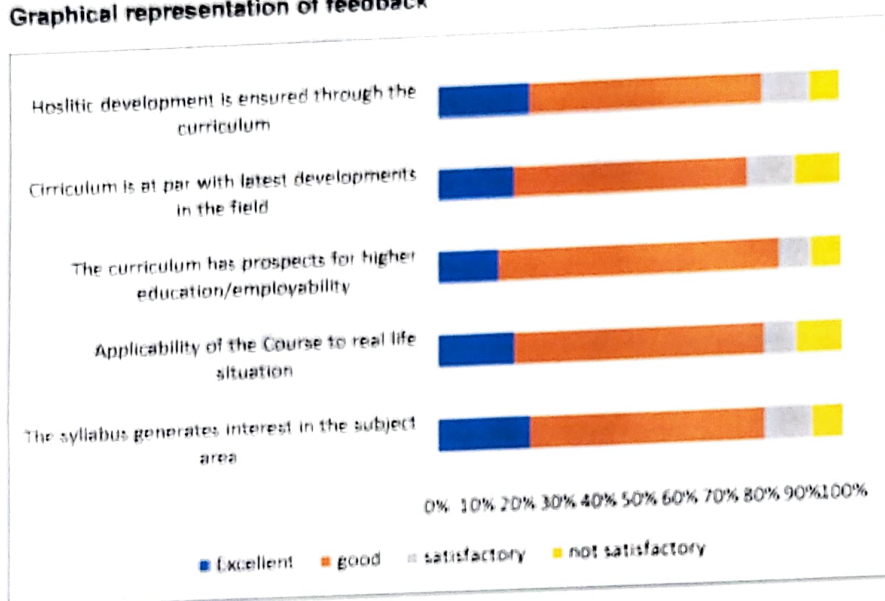

B) Student Feedback Analysis on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022



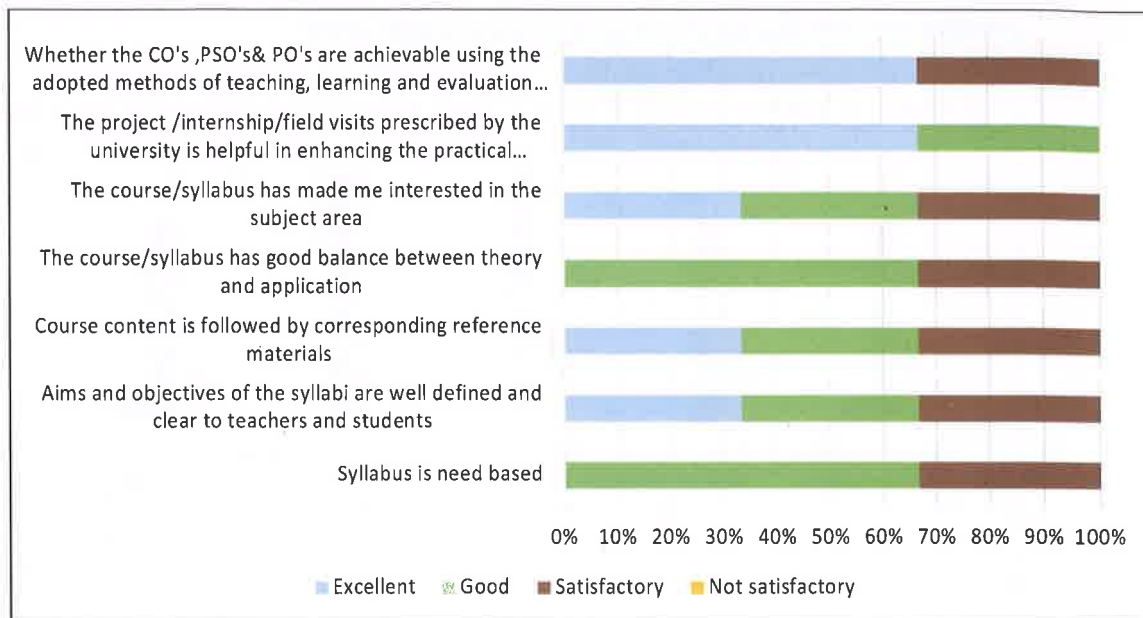

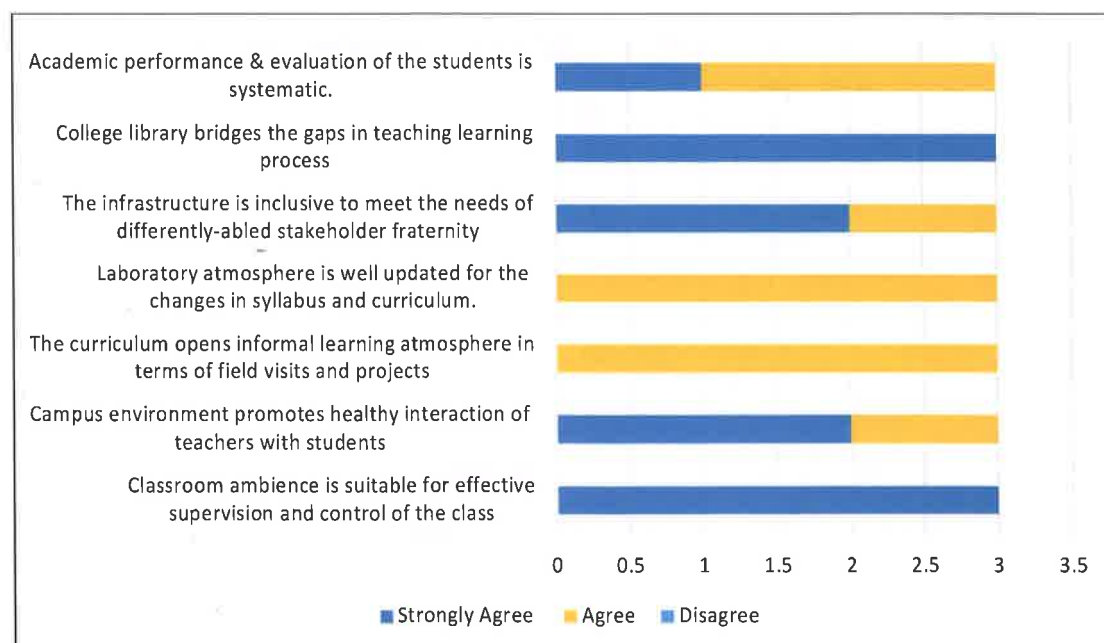

B) Teacher's Feedback Analysis on ambience and academic performance of the Institution 2021-2022



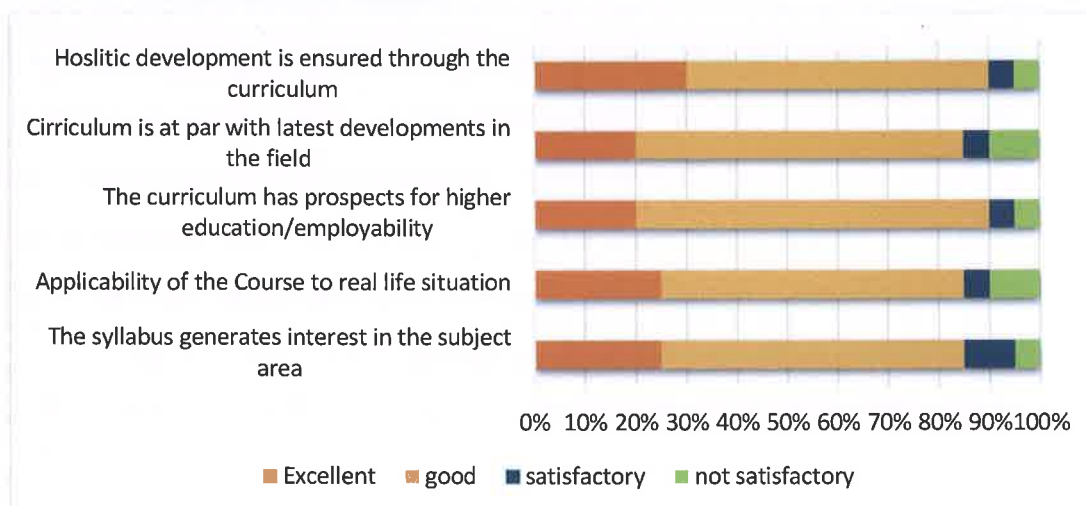

Graphical representation of feedback



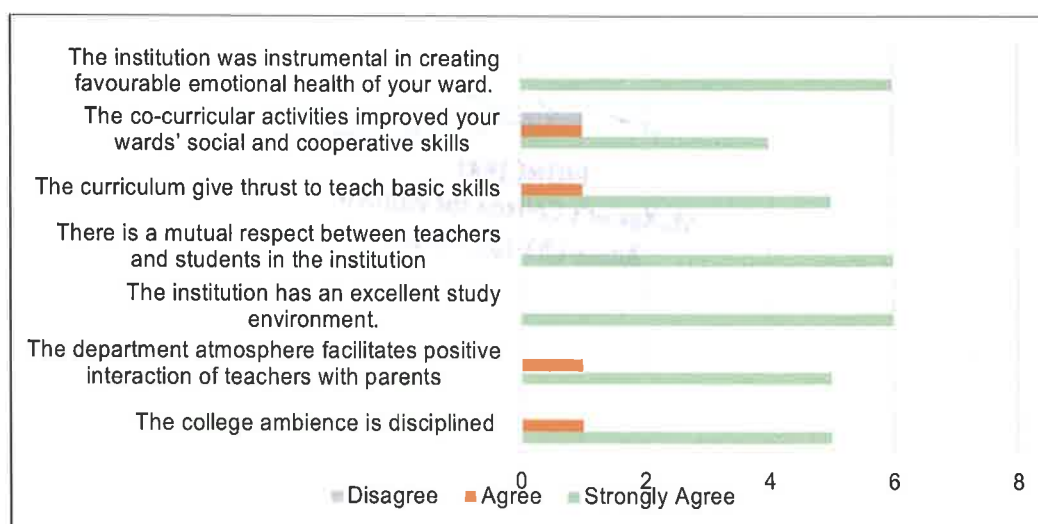

Action Taken Report on Feedback analysis


As per the syllabus of M.Sc.Microbiology the practical sessions are of 10 hours duration in first three semesters and 12 hours in the last semester. The current syllabus design poses time constraint due to which it is not possible to increase practical hours beyond the prescribed hours. Since the syllabus was revised last year, it is practically difficult to implement a change in syllabus immediately. The matter shall be brought to the notice of the chairman for syllabus revision in future as and when the meeting is convened. Other decisions include:

- Directed the students to actively participate in the group discussions and placement drives
- To include topics & internship programs in the curriculum. that enhance employability.
- To conduct more life skill development programmes and classes
- To simplify the syllabus by introducing innovative teaching methods
- Since placement drive is not specific for microbiology, requested to include the same
- It was decided to take Add-on courses to address the gap in vocational subjects.
