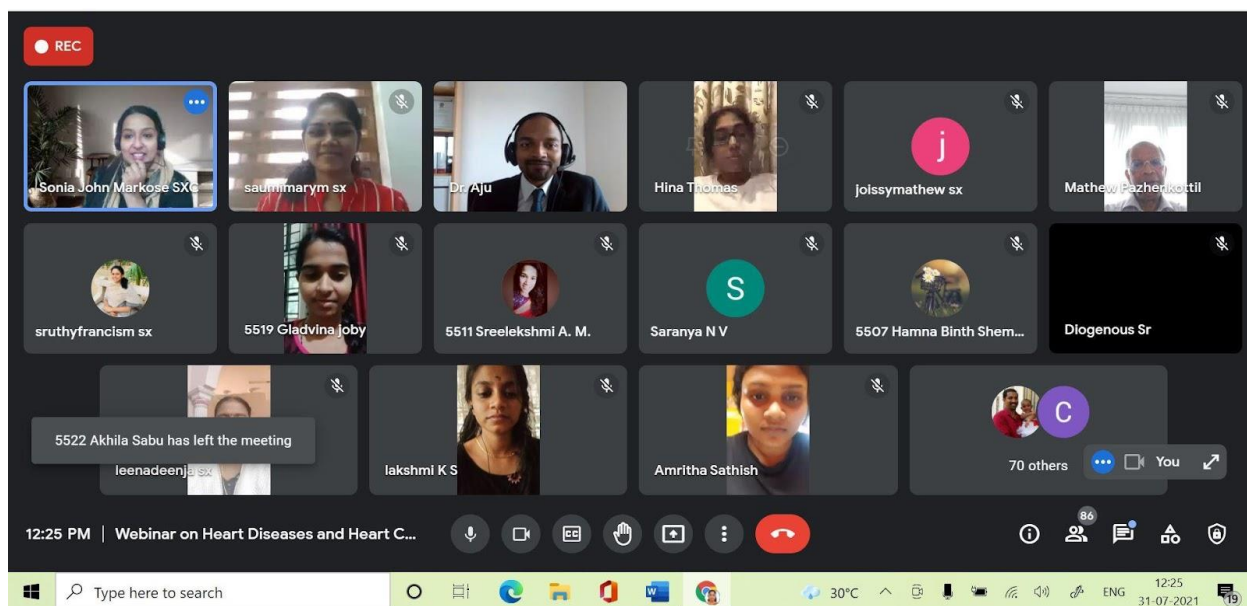

3. One Week Faculty Development Programme in Python 3.4.3
