#### **AARPOO IRROO 2K19: The Onam Celebration**

Onam celebration in the college was organized in a grand and traditional manner on 5th of September 2019 amidst great cheer and cultural extravaganza and witnessed mass participation of students. The 'pookkalam' was laid in the college auditorium by the Union members. As the Onam celebrations coincided with teacher's day, it was made more memorable by paying respect to all the teachers by welcoming them with a small gift and sweets. An interesting competition called 'maveliyumkootarum' was introduced this year by the college union which brought live the mythological characters related to Onam on stage. It was a creative visualization of Onam in its full glory. 
Throughout the year, the college union tried its very best to serve the students and management of the college. The following are the some of its contributions that can be pointed out as its highlights.


- ✓ The union bought new thiruvathira ornament set for the college. The fund

- ✓ Under the leadership of this union, the college won the best ever result in the University Youth festival.




