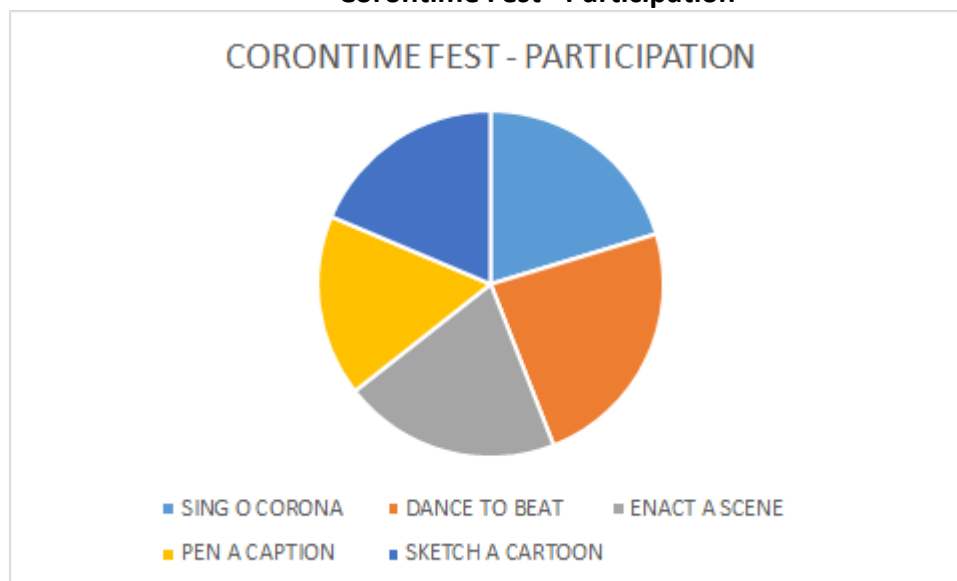
11. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

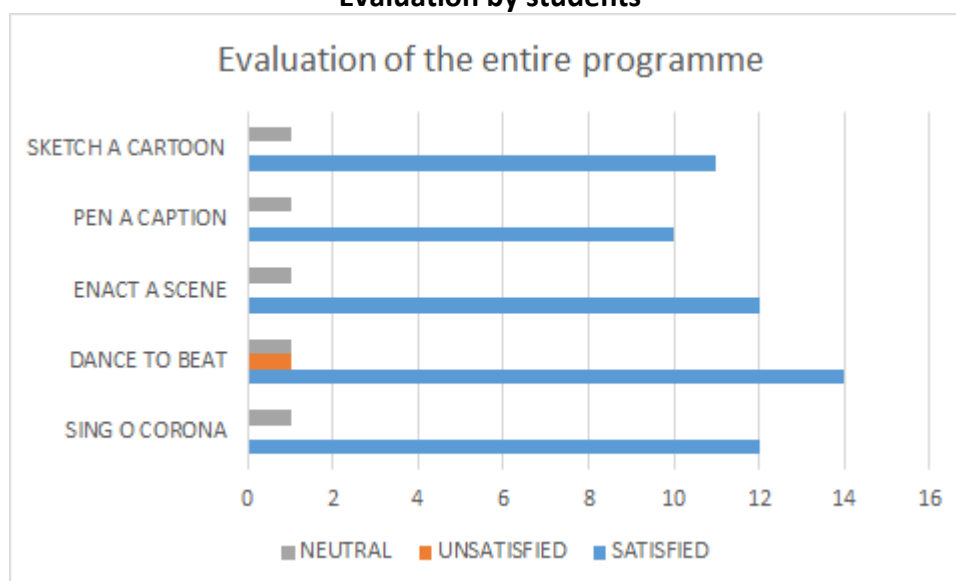
their pleasure in getting online platforms to showcase their talents even amidst the lock down.

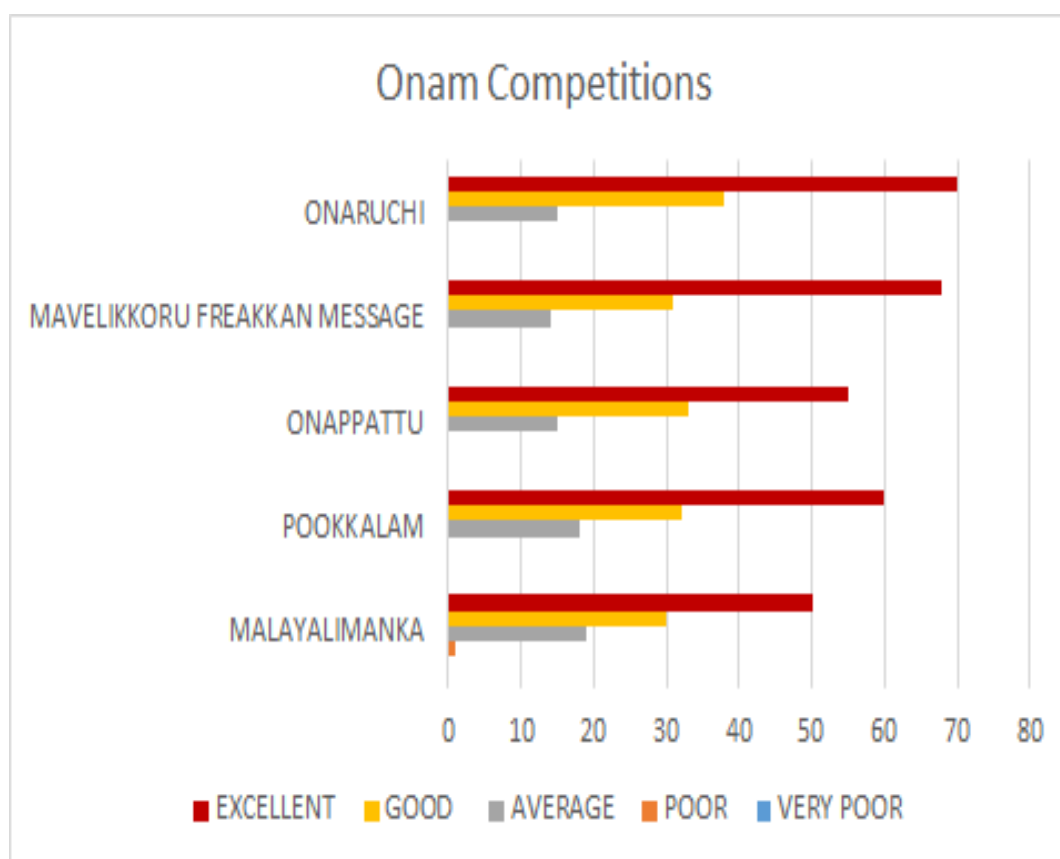
11. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

Though the entries were minimal, those who participated gave a strong and critical perspective about the movie. The entries came up both in English and Malayalam. They were evaluated by expert judges and winners were announced.

The Film Review Competition was on "Kappela", the Malayalam Movie. The students were motivated to watch the movie as it was the competition movie. By watching the movie the students got twofold benefit. The movie depicts the deception that ensnares the love relationships and how that will traumatically affect the girl victims.

While the students watched the movie, they got a chance to analyse about their lives too. Another advantage for the students was the opportunity to tune their critical way of thinking. The students were encouraged through this event to cultivate their critical perceptions and evaluative aptitude.

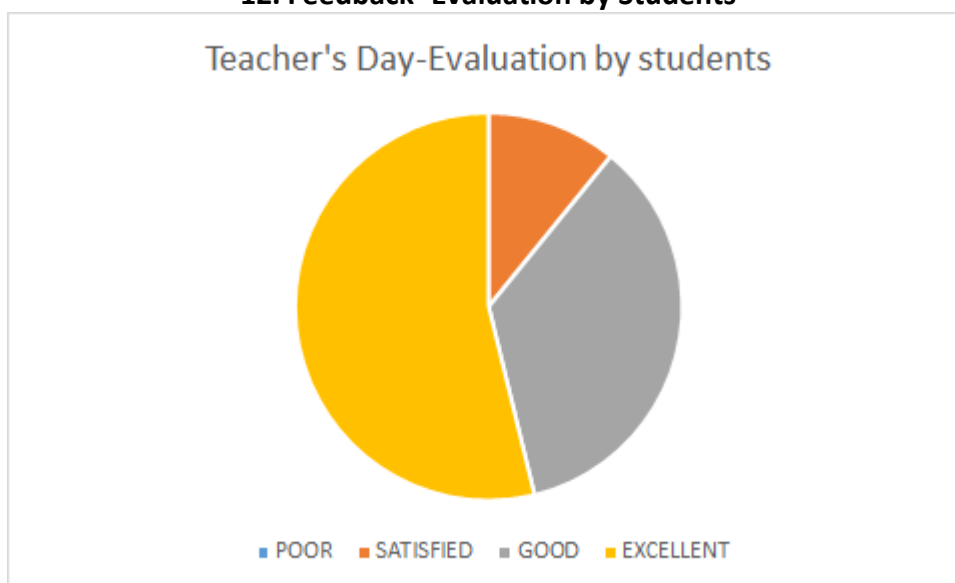
11. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

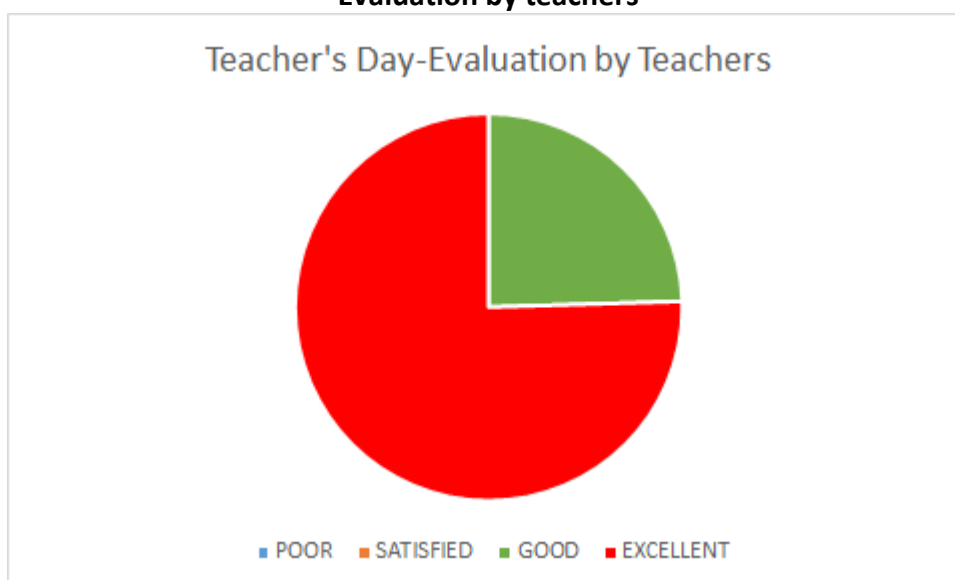
imparted a positive value to the student community. It reinstated the institutional values in the minds of the students in a forceful manner.

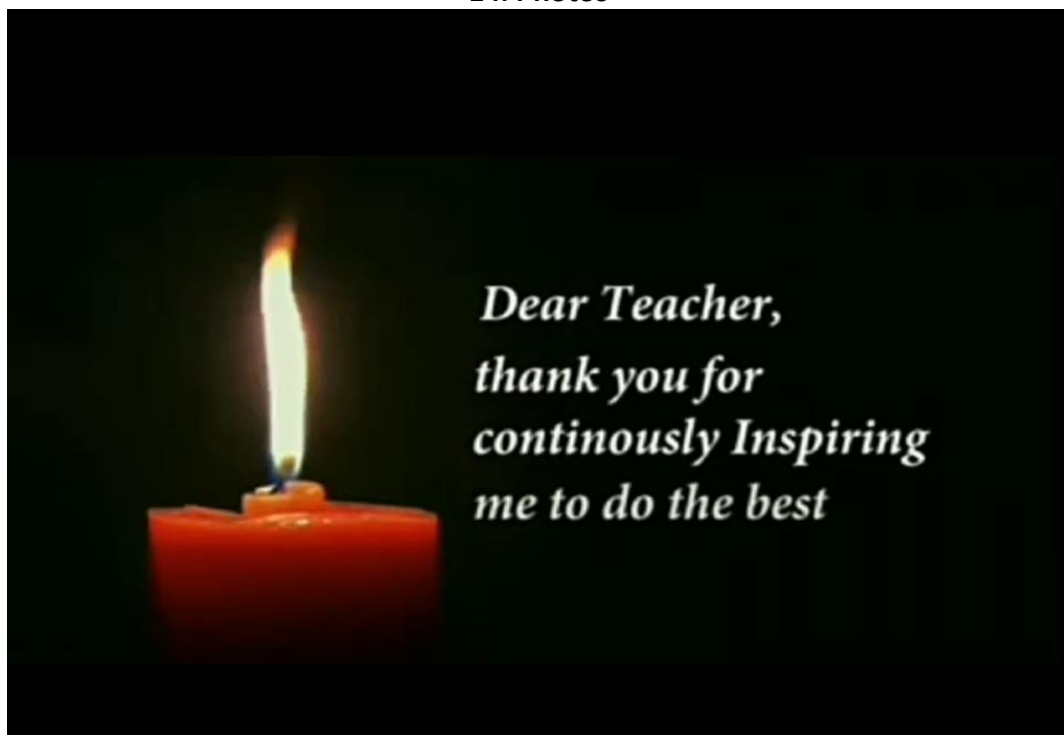

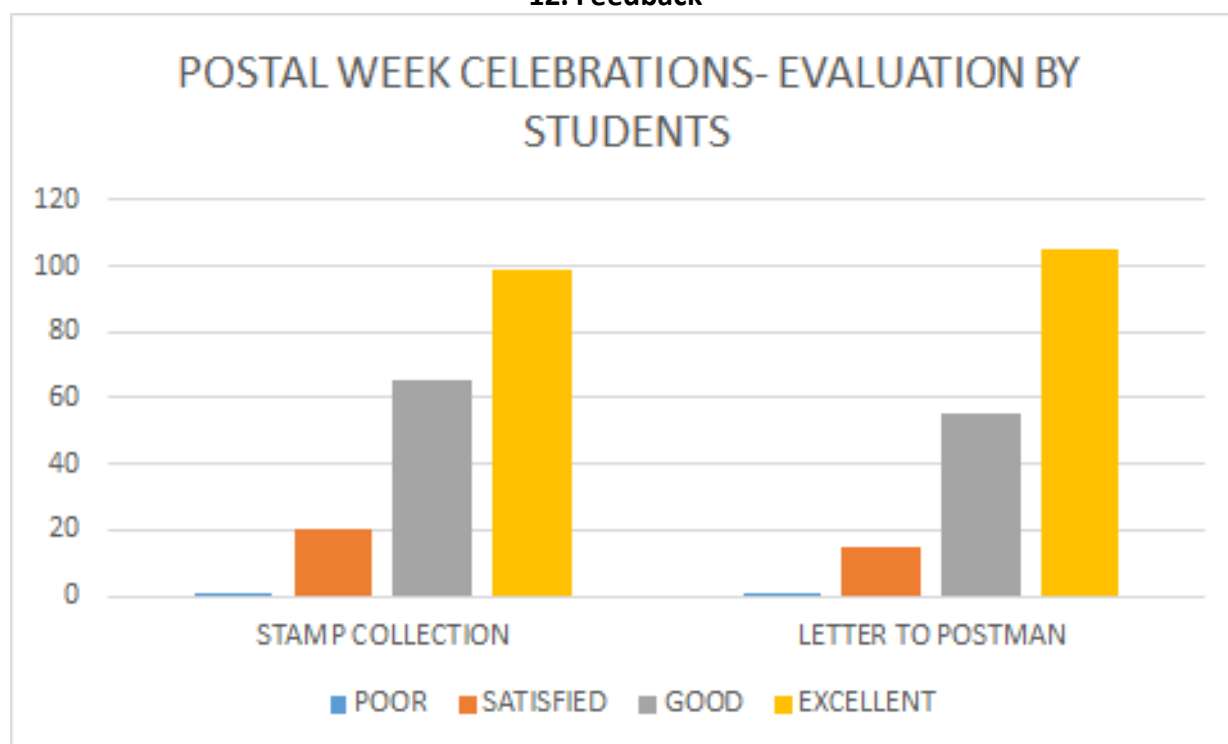
11. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

10. Detailed description of the event :

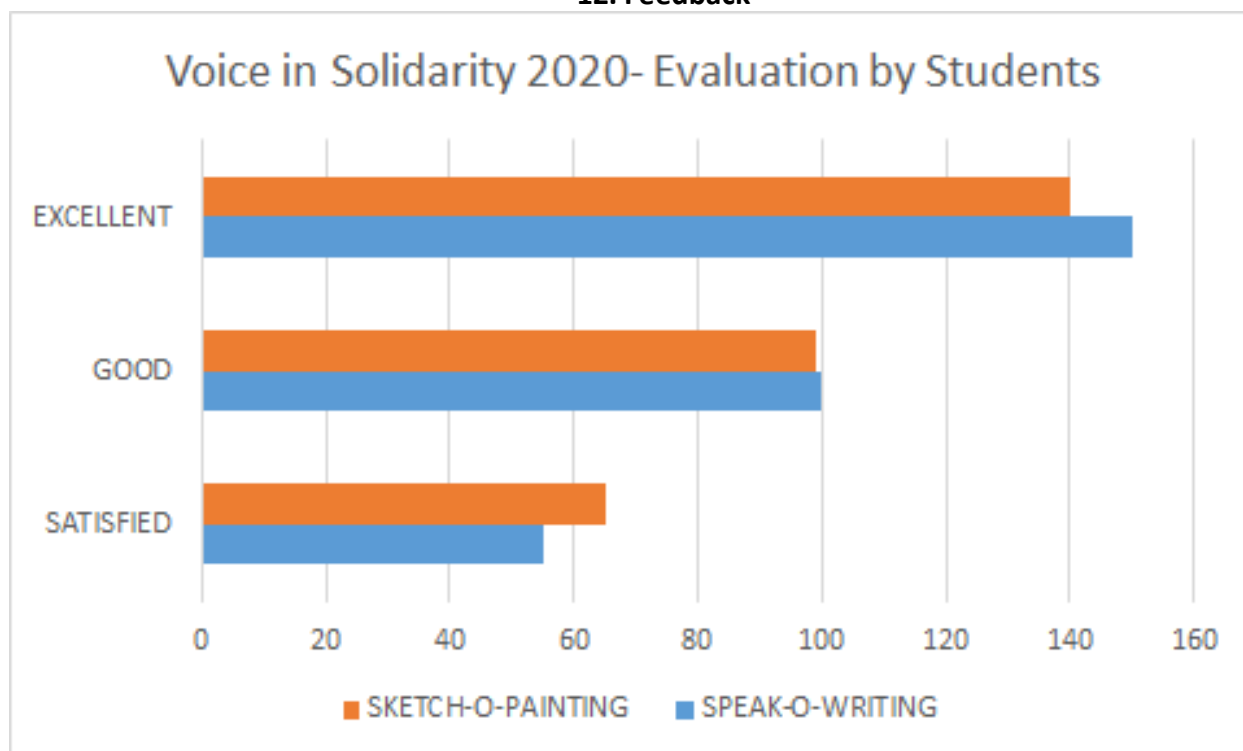

10. **Detailed description of the event** :

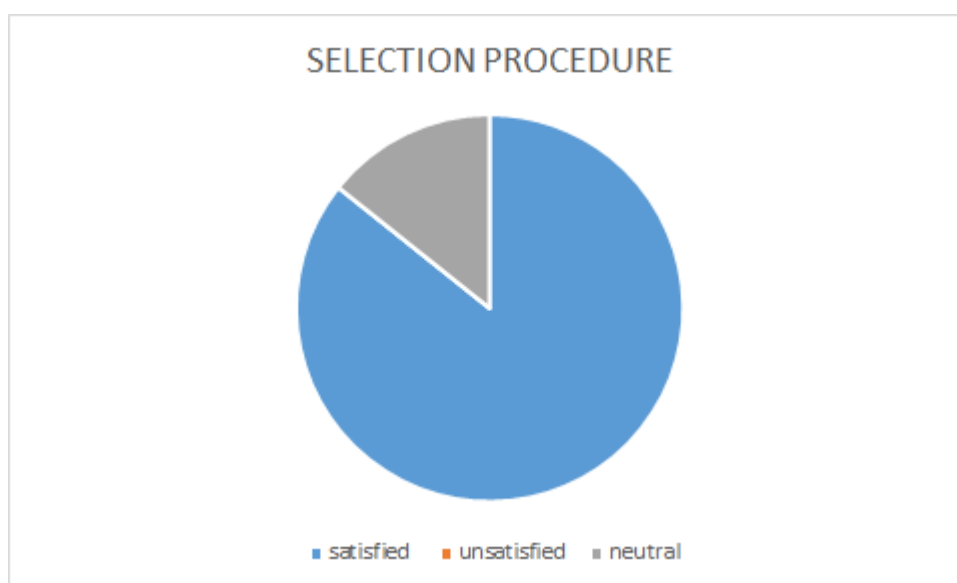

11. Outcome of the event/Evaluation by Program Coordinator:

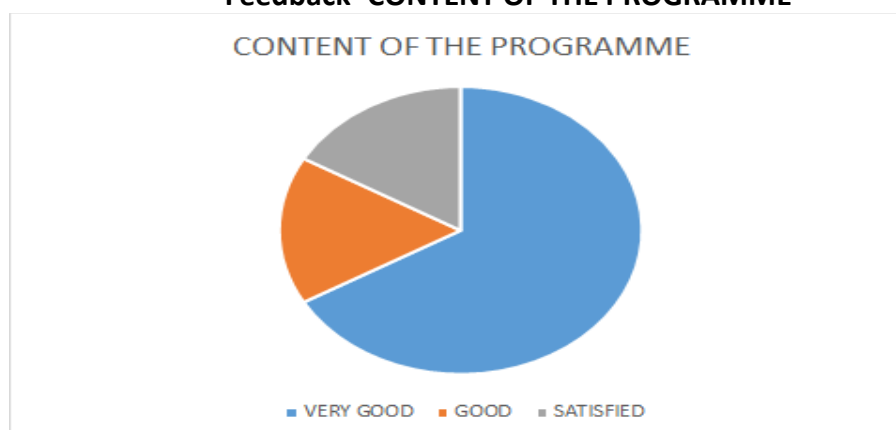
