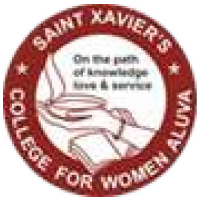

Activity 2. Freshers' Day

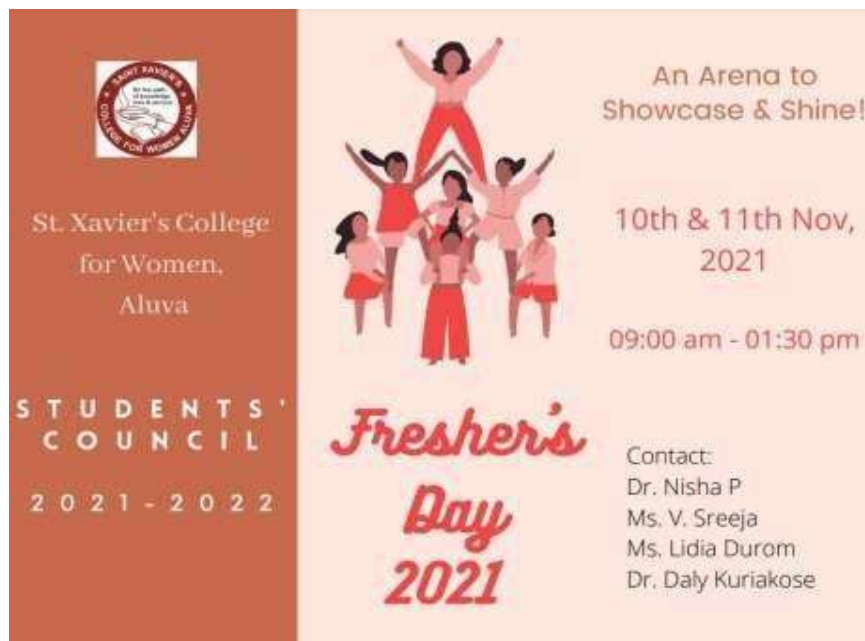
Description: FRESHER'S DAY CELEBRATION REPORT: 2020-21

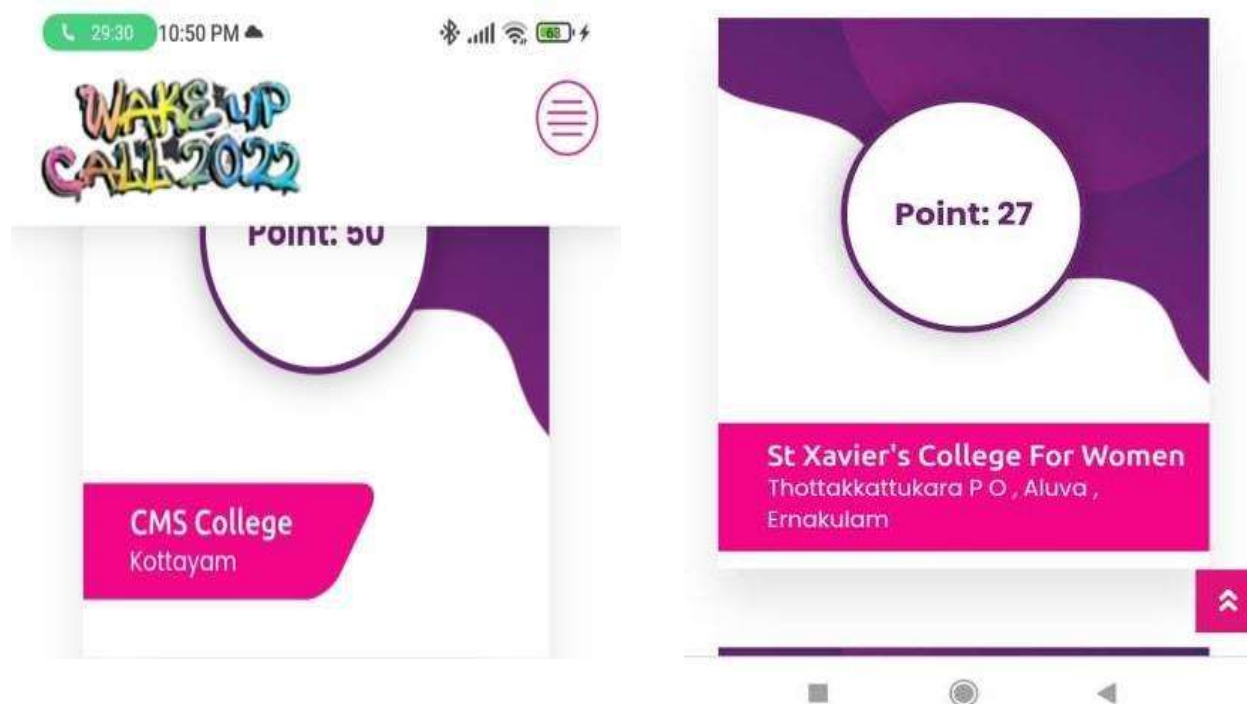
