The college has completed 5 cycles of NAAC accreditation acclaiming the status of the first college in India to win A++ Grade (CGPA 3.68) in the fifth cycle. The college 5-star rating (the only Arts and Science College from Kerala) in 2019-20 and 4-star rating (highest for the year) in 2020-2021 in the National IIC ranking and Certificate of Recognition from ATAL. The college has also been bestowed with UGC, DST-FIST, KSCSTE, ICSSR, DBT-STAR and RUSA funding gauging the potential of the college for vertical and horizontal growth.
