




7. The National Flag was hoisted in the college on Independence Day and Republic Day by Principal Pof Dr Milon Franz and was followed by cultural programs by the cadets.






8. Guard of Honour was given to the NAAC Peer Team on 9 th February 2023 and Cadets actively monitored the discipline duty on both days of NAAC visit.

12. The Unit Celebrated NCC day on 26 th Nov 2022 by cleaning the Aluva Manappuram and distributing the food packets to the needy.






13. Christmas Kits were prepared by the cadets and distributed to the needy in Madhavapuram Colony.






